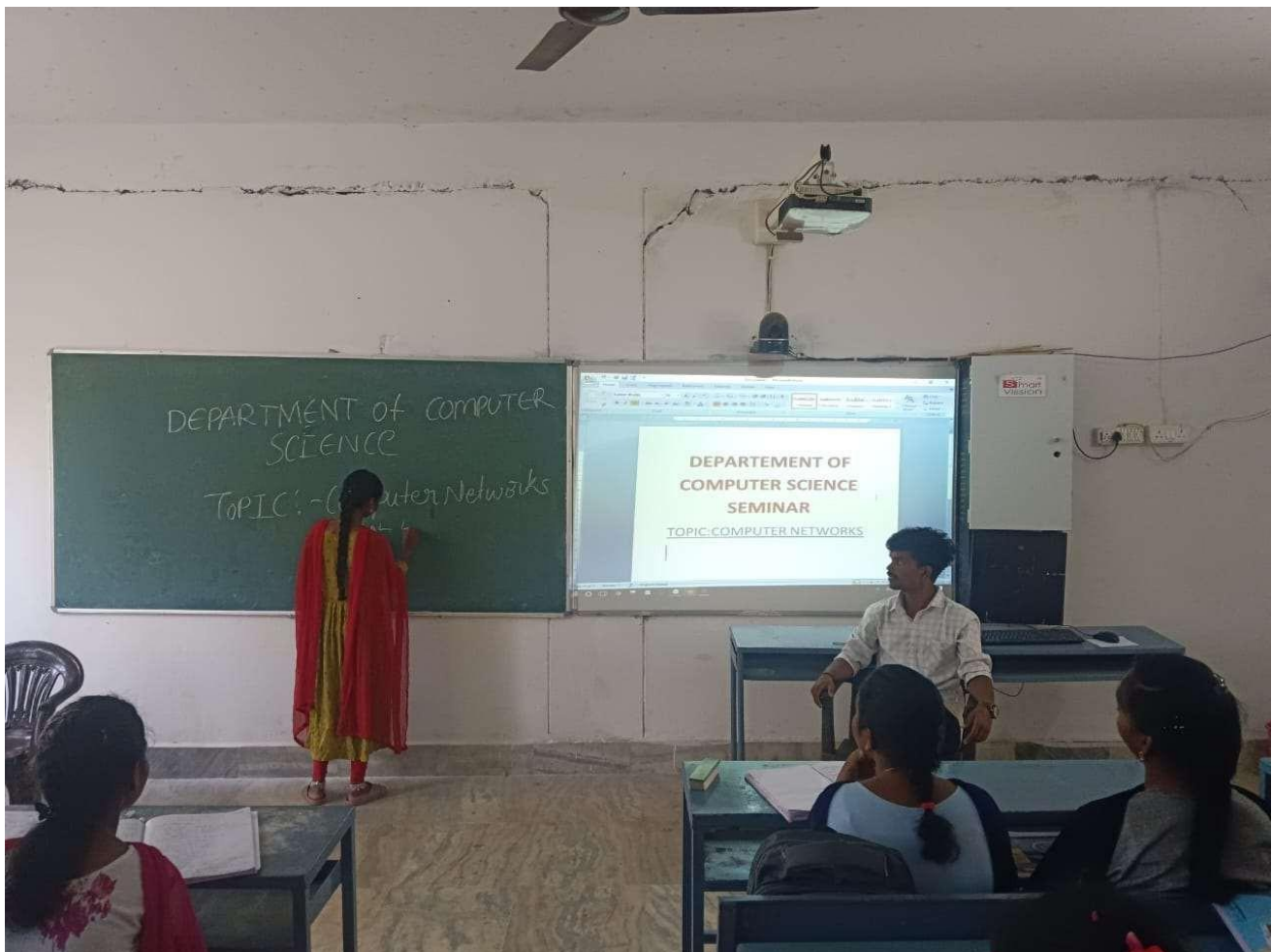

Number of Students Attended: 15

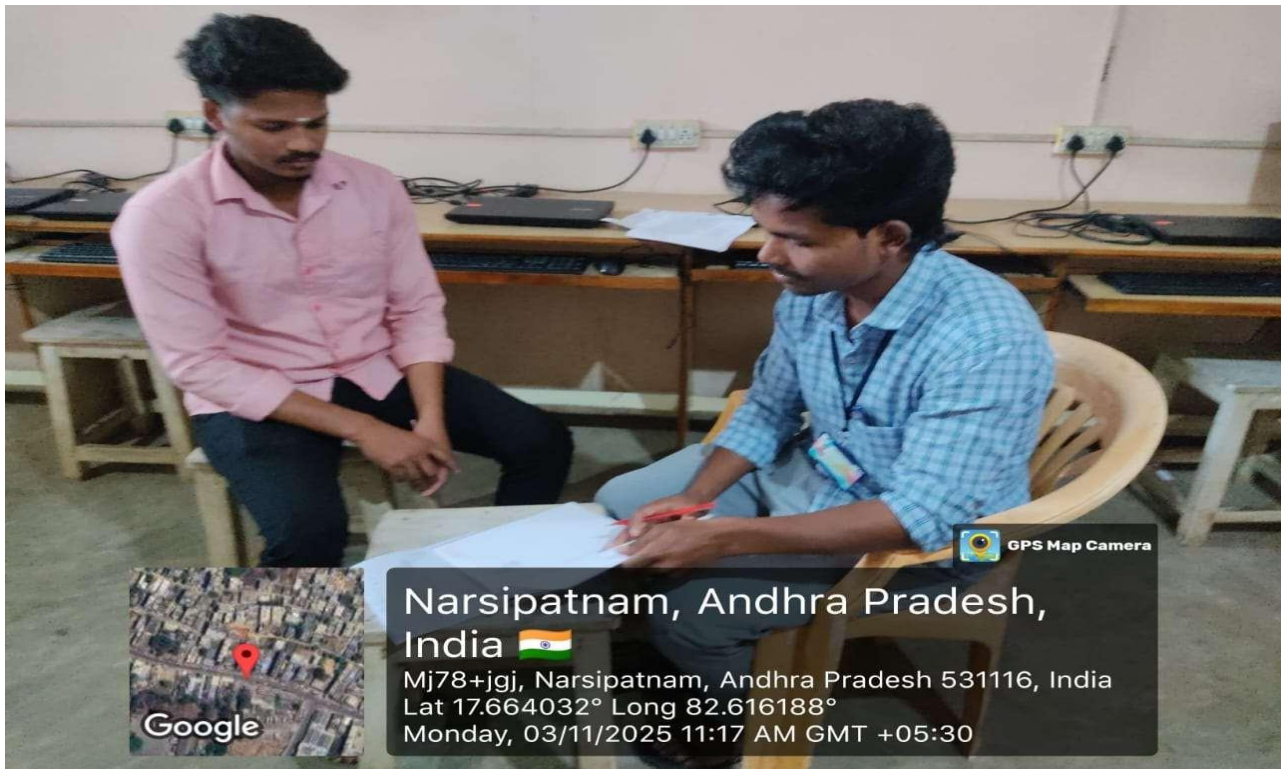

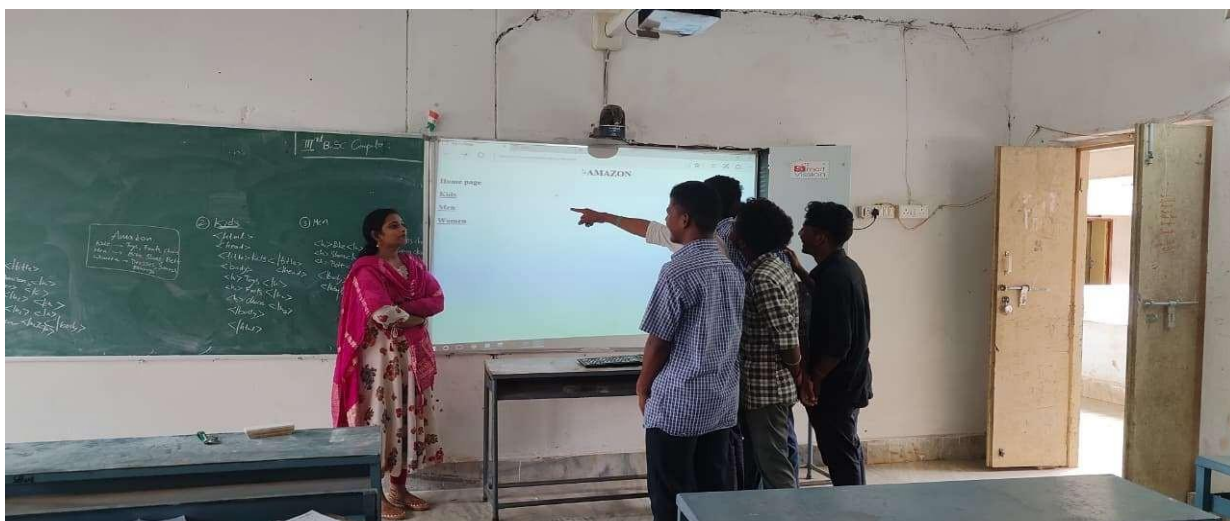
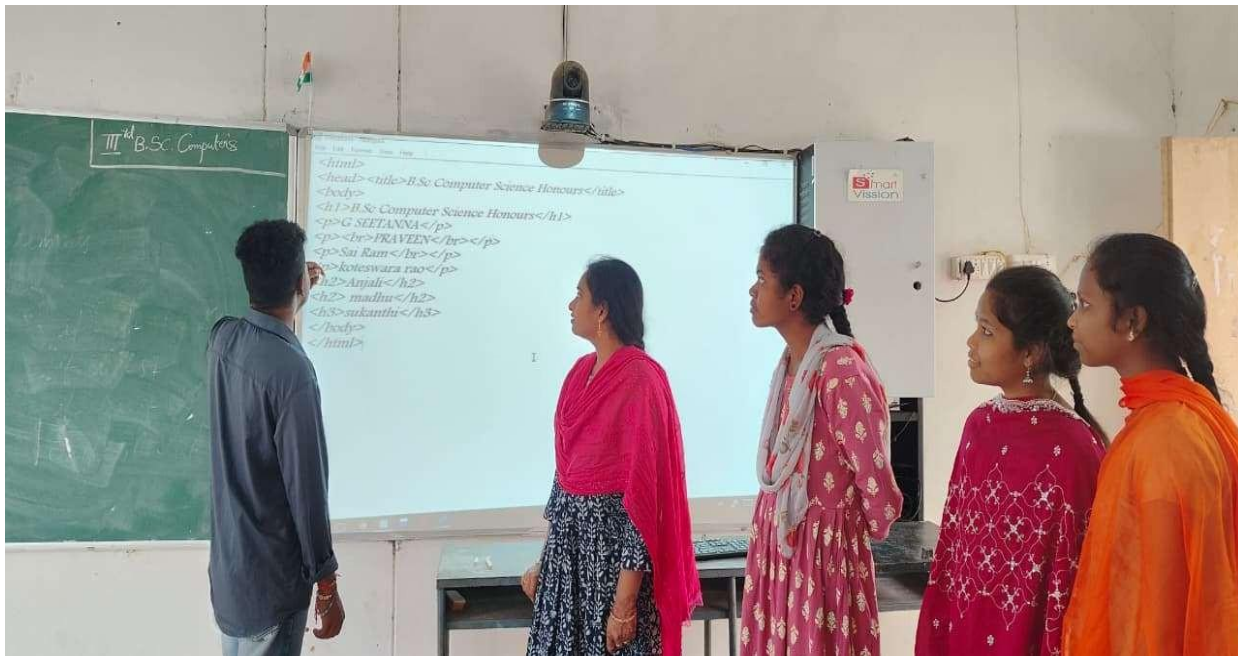


Name of the Activity : Student Seminar

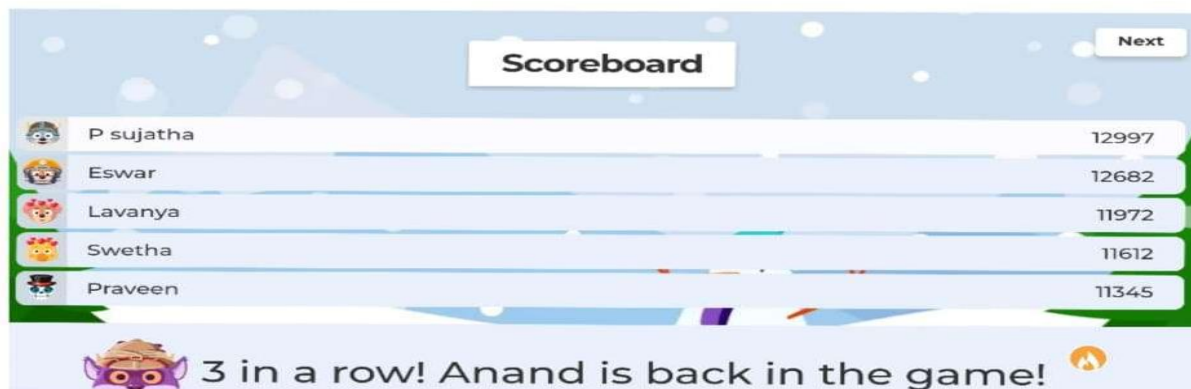
Name of the Activity : QUIZZ IN KAHOOT APP

- **Gamification:** Leaderboards and points created excitement and boosted involvement.

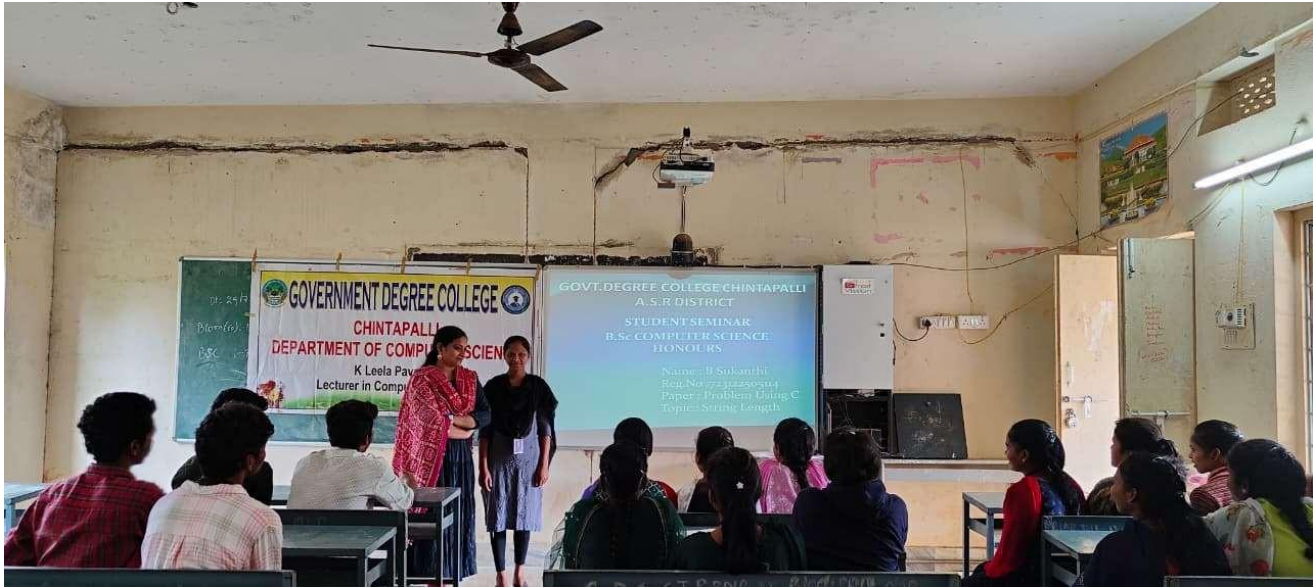
